The mission of the Utah Arts Festival is to promote the arts and enhance the quality of life in Utah through the production of an annual outdoor, multi-disciplinary event in downtown Salt Lake City. We strive to maintain the highest artistic quality in our production and programming, represent excellence among a range of artistic mediums, and promote an appreciation for fine art while encouraging innovation in the field, and supporting non-traditional, contemporary works.

As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, the Utah Arts Festival Foundation is funded by grants, private donations, and program revenue. Time & Location

The annual Festival takes place the 4th weekend of June each summer and is held downtown in Salt Lake City at Library and Washington Squares. A full time staff of three and one part time person work year-round to produce the Festival. In addition, we engage seasonal coordinators to help plan and implement artistic programs each year. A technical staff, stage and production crews, along with more than 1,000 volunteers rounds out the personnel needed to produce the annual event.

Admission Prices

- **Adult Admission:** \$15
- **Children 12 and under:** FREE
- **Thursday & Friday Lunchtime Special:** \$8 Noon to 3pm only
- **4-Day Festival Pass:** \$50
- **Seniors (65+)/Military:** \$8 (can only be purchased at Festival Box Office)
- **Bike Valet Special:** Receive \$2 off regular adult admission when you ride your bike and park at the Bike Lot (located on 400 South between State Street and 200 East, midblock)
- **Y'all Come Back Pass:** Pick up a Y'all Come Back Pass at box office when you purchase a ticket to receive a 2-for-1 admission on your return visit to the Festival.
